(VMCC) will hold under the above permit the Baydale Road Safety Run on 5 September 2010 for motorcycles, cyclecars and tricycles manufactured before 1st January 1986. The event is open to members of the VMCC current membership card must be presented at the start. Non members must apply for One Day membership by completing the form above (fee £3) Untaxed machines will not be allowed to start.

**Competition:** Riders will be observed for correct machine handling and road safety and will be required to answer questions on road safety and motorcycling history. Ties will be decided in the following sequence: oldest machine; smallest capacity machine; furthest cleanest.

**Awards** for overall performance and class will be presented at Walworth Castle in January 2010. Results will be announced at the end of the run.

**Route:** Start 10 am and Finish: Cricket Club Middleton St George, situated east of Darlington off the A67.. Route sheets will be issued. **Lunch stop:** St Johns Chapel **Distance:** 90 miles along country lanes in Durham Dales. Veteran and small capacity machines may be started early at organisers discretion.
