Announcement and Eligibility: The South Durham Section of the Vintage Motorcycle Club Ltd. (VMCC) will hold, the Quaker Road Safety Run on 19th May 2024 for motorcycles, cyclecars and tricycles manufactured before 1st January 1999. The event is open to members of the VMCC, who must produce their current membership card at the start. Non members must apply for One Day membership by completing the appropriate form at the start (fee £5).

Competition: Riders may be observed for correct machine handling and road safety and will be required to answer questions on the Highway Code and motorcycling history. Ties will be decided in the following sequence: oldest machine; smallest capacity machine; furthest cleanest. This is a qualifying event in the Northern Road Run Championship. Machines will be judged on appearance and desirability.

Awards: Overall performance, class awards and three Concours de Elegance trophies presented in Jan 2025. Results announced at finish 3.50pm approx. Entrants will receive a commemorative badge.

Route: Start 10.15am, & **Finish:** 3.45 @ Baydale Beck Public House Low Coniscliffe, Darlington DL2 2JX on the A67. Route sheets issued at the start. Petrol on route. **Lunch stop:** Reeth North Yorkshire; choice of cafe's and pubs. **Distance:** 90 miles along country lanes and steep hills in Teesdale and Swaledale. Veteran and small capacity machines will be started early at organisers discretion.

Entries: on the official *entry declaration* (above), accompanied by the fee (£5.00). Return to the Secretary by 16th May or earlier please. Late entries maybe accepted at the start but please inform the Secretary before the day of the event. Enclose addressed envelope for copy of results.
