



Quattro Plant British SuperSport Oulton Park Round

The weekend was looking good for us following a positive weekend at Brands Hatch GP, the test day started well managing to match our previous personal best lap time from the start of the year, trying some new suspension settings in the bike which made it feel a lot more stable in the faster corners

Saturday qualifying was strong managing to put a solid lap time in and place well on the grid for the sprint race later on the Saturday afternoon. The race started out well managing to slot in behind the leading SuperSport Cup bike and managing to smash our old PB lap and get a 1.39.3 and finishing P4 respectably in class after a close race.

Sunday race day, the weather was looking good, another hot dry day perfect for a long 14 lap race of the Oulton Park circuit. Starting from P2 in the cup class and row 7 on the full SuperSport grid this was the highest we had been this year, another strong start and a long race at the front of the class, managing to get another PB lap time of a 1.39.0 fractionally off being the 38s, also claiming 3rd position in the class finishing the weekend of with a podium.

Over all a really strong weekend for us and the bike putting us a great place for the next round at Thruxton race circuit in a weeks time
