Announcement and Eligibility: The South Durham Section of the Vintage Motorcycle Club Ltd. (VMCC) will hold under the above permit 50th Anniversary Sunset Road Safety Run on 6th July 2026 for motorcycles, cyclecars and tricycles manufactured before 1st January 2001. The event is open to members of the VMCC, current membership card to be presented at start. Non members must complete the One Day membership form.

Competition: Riders will be observed for correct machine handling and road safety and will be required to answer questions on road safety and motorcycling history. Ties will be decided in the following sequence: oldest machine; smallest capacity machine; furthest cleanest.

Awards: Overall performance and class awards are available. These will be presented at the Presentation dinner in January 2027. Results may be announced at the end of the run.

Route: Start 6.00 pm and Finish: Middlesbrough & District Motor Club, Coulby Manor Coulby Newham TS8 0RP. Route sheets will be issued at the start. Distance: 45 miles. Pie and Pea supper available at additional cost.

Entries: on the official form. and returned to the Secretary by 2nd July. Entry fee £0 in recognition of the Sections 50th anniversary. Some late entries may be accepted at the start but please inform the Secretary before the day of the event.
